

**THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL**  
**ORDER UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847**  
**FOR THE PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTION ON HIGHWAYS**  
**NORTH CAVE REMEMBRANCE DAY PARADE**  
**VARIOUS ROADS IN NORTH CAVE**

On 4th November 2022 The East Riding of Yorkshire Council made a regulation under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 which will be operative on Sunday 13th November 2022. The effect of the regulation will be:-

1. To prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed along the following lengths of road:-

<b><u>Lengths of road to be closed</u></b>	<b><u>Period of Closure</u></b>
<b>Church Lane</b> - the whole extent <b>Church Street</b> - between the junctions with Church Lane and Appleton Lane <b>Appleton Lane</b> - the full extent <b>Westgate</b> - between Appleton Lane and Eastfield junction	Sunday 13th November 2022 between 11:30 hours and 11:45 hours  These closures will operate as rolling road closures and roads will be reopened once the parade has passed consistent with maintaining public safety

2. The Regulation will not extend to emergency vehicles.
3. The East Riding of Yorkshire Council (On Street Parking Places)(Civil Enforcement)(Consolidation) Order 2021 is hereby suspended for the areas listed for the duration of this Order.
4. The Regulation may be examined during normal office hours from the date of this Notice until 13th November 2022, at Brough Customer Service Centre, Petuaria Centre, Centurion Way, Brough HU15 1AY, and Beverley Customer Service Centre, Cross Street, Beverley HU17 9BA.
